



What happens if I don't pay dues or comply with the Teamster's rules?

The Teamsters could get you fired. From the SoCal Agreement: <u>Article 2</u>

Section 3. The Company shall not continue the employment of any employees covered by this Agreement after seven (7) calendar days written notice has been received from the Union that such member is not in good standing.

The Teamsters cannot force me to pay, right?

WRONG. Recent lawsuits filed the Teamsters against their members:

- Collection of \$3,346.79 in dues.
- Collection of \$371.73 in dues.
- Collection of \$1,929.48 in fines (2x what the member made when crossing a picket line).
- Collection of \$2,110.00 in fines including fines for not attending a general membership meeting & not walking picket line.
